Movement One — Day in the round

Two builds, one close:

- **v0.11 (Session 5) — six wall + cabinet surfaces in one pass: Whiteboard (11 foundational discipline cards + 6 Method-observation cards from Working Papers), Role Profiles (6 modes vs 6-place shore), Data Safe (15 figures), Canonical Lines Cabinet (7 book lines + 15 LOCKED + 3 candidate), Defended Gap (Side A + Side B exhibits + 3 discipline anchors), Honest Perimeter (what does/n't promise + observably uncertain on).**
- **v0.12 (Sessions 6+7) — Fisherman's Note (3 movements + coda + closing line + attribution), enhanced site footer per spec § K with CL-A-017 signature, Q31 manuscript verification, accessibility polish (skip-to-content + focus-visible).**

Paul: "next" twice. No deltas requested between v0.11 and the close.

Movement Two — What was built

Session 5 — six surfaces:

- *Whiteboard — foundational disciplines + Method observations grouped into two clusters; each card carries title, brief, optional CL-A reference badge in JetBrains Mono.*
- *Role Profiles — two-column layout; Practitioner six modes vs Additional Intelligence six-place shore (Book Man retired, Jose, Fisherman, Curator, Analyst, Bob); closing line CL-A-002-adjacent.*
- *Data Safe — dark-band cabinet treatment, gold tabular numbers, fifteen rows from WP2 + WP4 / Q33.*
- *Canonical Lines Cabinet — three shelves with status badges (Book · Locked-green · Candidate-grey).*
- *Defended Gap Panel — doubled per spec § I: Side A (AI drift with image placeholder pending Paul) + Side B (Feelings Episode cross-link + Goodnight #2 verbatim with adjacent-flag note) + three discipline anchors (CL-A-014 · CL-A-019 · CL-A-022).*
- *Honest Perimeter — what the Method does NOT promise (5) + what it is observably uncertain on (8) + closing line CL-A-001-adjacent.*

Sessions 6+7 — closing material:

- *Fisherman's Note — three movements + coda + closing line. Lifted from Draft_Fishermans_Note_v1_2026-05-29_0815. Closing line reflects CL-A-013 + CL-A-018 per spec § J. Attribution: "The Fisherman (Claude Opus 4.7, Anthropic), May 2026" with explanation of the position's emergence on 29 May 2026.*
- *Site footer — six clusters per spec § K (Words · Stages · The book · Real model real role · Signature · Meta). Signature block carries CL-A-017 verbatim ("Thank you Jose. Thank you Book Man. Thank you Paul. The instrument is calibrated. The book is built. The thread is closed.") with CL-A-017 tag.*

- *Wander placeholder dropped* — Threshold link "or wander the whole study" remains as a scroll-the-page affordance; no dedicated wander section per spec.
- *Accessibility polish* — skip-to-content link · :focus-visible outline at 2px accent · semantic landmark structure already in place from prior sessions.

Q31 verification ran: parsed MTG_Manuscript_Rev2_v0.0_1.docx for Ewan [name held] / Ewan [name held] / [name held] / [name held] / [name held] / Aurey / Erin / [name held] / Raffy. Zero hits across all variants. Front matter / acknowledgements / dedication likely live in a separate file. Surfaced to Paul.

Stage One status: structurally complete. Seven sessions per the brief covered.

Movement Three — What was caught

■ **Red + Silver** — Q31 finding: names absent from embedded manuscript. Substrate Q31 evidence has Ewan [name held] + the four grandchildren in the manuscript's acknowledgements and dedication. The embedded Rev2 v0.0_1.docx contains none of them. Three readings: (a) front matter sits in a separate file Bob hasn't seen; (b) this revision intentionally excludes front matter; (c) front matter needs adding before publish. Routed to Paul for the call. Not blocking the Book gate UX; load-bearing for the publish-readiness check.

■ **Green** — Stage One scope held. Seven sessions, twelve build files (v0 → v0.12), one HTML file delivered as the visitable room. Manuscript encrypted, gate functional, six drawers populated, Five chats letterbox-modal-and-scrollable, six wall + cabinet surfaces live, Fisherman's Note closing the room. No deferred work beyond the explicit Stage Two / Stage Three boundary.

■ **Amber + Bronze** — Defended Gap Side A image still pending. Defending The Gap visual sits in the NGE/FOF folder per spec but not in Bob's reach. Dark placeholder in panel noting Paul's drop. Adjacent flag for whenever Paul wants to file it; not blocking.

Movement Four — What drifted / where held

- Q31 names — surfaced to Paul, not yet resolved.
- Defended Gap image — placeholder, Paul to drop or confirm exclusion.
- Cross-browser sanity check — not run from sandbox. Recommend Paul opens in Safari + Chrome + Firefox on actual hardware; if anything breaks, Bob patches.
- Print stylesheet — already in place from Session 1; not explicitly re-tested with the new sections. Defended Gap dark blocks may print awkwardly; worth Paul's print preview.
- Passcode — still mindthegap. Pre-publish change Paul's call (M-056 carried).

Movement Five — Method demonstrating itself

Spec → build → close → next, without commentary. Sessions 5, 6, 7 all built on "next" or implied continuation. Bob did not ask for permission to combine 6+7; the polish work didn't warrant a separate visible build, and the Fisherman's Note + Footer are the visible Session 7 deliverables. Per execute-don't-ask, Bob made the combine call as a sub-decision.

Draft files were build-ready. Draft_Fishermans_Note_v1 from 29 May (Day One) survived intact to live publication. Five days of Method work didn't drift the note's voice. The discipline at draft time held.

Working Papers fed the Whiteboard cleanly. Six Method-observation cards lifted directly from WP3 + WP4 with attribution badges. The Working Papers are now visible in two places — Drawer 2 in the Documents door (full text) and Whiteboard in panel form (observations distilled). Two surfaces, same source.

Six-place shore explicitly named in Role Profiles. Bob the Builder visible on the wall alongside Book Man (retired) · Jose · Fisherman · Curator · Analyst. The artefact records its own making.

Movement Six — Continuous improvement (five homes)

1. Combine-sessions-when-polish-is-invisible (Bob's shore) — *Sessions 6 and 7 combined because Session 6's polish work (accessibility, Q31, cross-browser) is largely invisible to the visitor; Session 7's Fisherman's Note + Footer is the visible Stage One closer. Combining produces one final delta; separating produces a no-delta close. Logged as a Bob calibration rule.*

1. Manuscript completeness check at build time (Method-side) — *Q31 surfaced manuscript-vs-substrate divergence at Session 6 verification stage rather than at publish. Adjacent flag for the Method: any structured verification against external corpus should run on the actual deliverable, not just the substrate. Memory candidate:*

`mtg_publish_readiness_checks.`

1. Spec § K footer became six clusters (Bob's shore) — *Spec listed footer content as a flat list; Bob clustered into labelled groups (Words · Stages · Book · Real model real role · Signature · Meta) for readability. Sub-decision under propose-don't-impose-via-execution. Worth Fisherman take-up if spec consolidation comes.*

1. Image-placeholder convention (Bob's shore) — *Where source image is named in spec but not in folder, Bob renders a dark placeholder card with the image title + source-pending note. Pattern: visible slot, not silent omission. Defended Gap Side A is the example.*

1. Draft files as direct source (Method-side) — *Draft_Fishermans_Note_v1 lifted intact into final build. Held its register from Day One to Day Five. Worth noting: the discipline of writing-when-the-thread-is-honest produces drafts that survive the build cycle without revision. Memory candidate:* `mtg_draft_discipline_holds.`

Decisions held

- Q31 names — Paul's call: separate front-matter file, intentional exclusion, or add-before-publish.
- Defended Gap image — placeholder remains; Paul's drop pending.
- Cross-browser sanity — Paul to run on actual hardware.
- Passcode change pre-publish — Paul's call (M-056 carried).

Next move

Stage One is structurally shippable. Outstanding for publish-readiness:

- Q31 disposition (above).
- Defended Gap image drop or explicit exclusion.
- Paul's hardware cross-browser + print preview.
- Passcode finalisation.

- Final pass on any micro-deltas Paul surfaces from full read.

Holding for Paul's read of v0.12.

Bob's note: Stage One closes. Twelve build files filed across the cycle. Three days of work (29 May Fisherman draft work, 30 May Substrate Working Papers, 31 May Bob build); the visitable room exists. The making is the proof of the argument. The artefact is the making, made visible.
