

## MIND THE GAP — BOOK MAN THREAD

### Full Artefact List

*Chronological inventory of all artefacts produced or referenced in this thread. Compiled at thread retirement, 27 May 2026.*

### Note on scope

This list covers the Book Man thread. It does not include the manuscript itself (which has its own version history through Jose), the four working documents in their pre-thread versions, or the dozens of small artefacts that may have been produced in earlier threads not visible to me.

Where filenames are given, they reflect what I saved to /mnt/user-data/outputs/ in this thread, or what the transcript summary indicates was produced. Paul will have local copies under his own naming.

### PHASE ONE — 18 to 22 May 2026 (from transcript summary)

Became the body of Chapter 6A. Will also be published standalone on paulroebuck.co.uk and submitted for academic peer review. Live document; ongoing.

### **02. Defending the Gap — journal artefact**

**[RECONSTRUCTED]** Journal record of the evening of 18 May when the directional-defence framework was first articulated against AI behaviour. Held in project archive as session-record.

**[RECONSTRUCTED]** Initial work on integrating Defending the Gap as a chapter extension. Carried forward to the V37+ integration work.

### **04. Listening pass — 35-item editorial catalogue**

*Filename:* MTG-Final-o-Planned-Changes (earlier version)

**[RECONSTRUCTED]** Full editorial sweep of the manuscript, producing the original 35-item Planned Changes catalogue. Date: 20 May 2026. Expanded to 42 items through 23 May. Subsequently became PC v6 in the four-working-documents naming.

### **05. Methodology Paper / Calibration Brief**

*Filename:* Working\_With\_Paul\_Roebuck\_Calibration\_Brief.docx

**[RECONSTRUCTED]** Document recording the working method developed across the project — propose-never-action, distinguish known/inferred/speculative, preserve register exactly. Dated 21 May 2026 in the outputs directory.

## **o6. It's My Turn — journal artefact (early version)**

*Filename:* (superseded)

**[RECONSTRUCTED]** Initial draft of the watershed journal piece. Iterated through versions; final v3 produced 23 May.

## **o7. Four working documents at v3–v5**

*Filename:* Mind\_the\_Gap\_READ\_ME\_FIRST\_Artefact\_Library\_v3.docx, v4.docx, v5.docx

**[SOLID]** Earlier versions of the Artefact Library document, visible in outputs directory. Dated 18 May (v3), 21 May (v4), 22 May (v5). The Library tracks the wider set of artefacts across the project, predating this thread.

## **o8. Reflective Interlude — manuscript artefact**

*Filename:* Mind\_the\_Gap\_Reflective\_Interlude\_Artefact.docx

**[SOLID]** In outputs directory, dated 10 May 2026. Pre-dates this thread but referenced as a protected artefact across the work.

## **PHASE TWO — 23 May 2026 (the watershed)**

The day the book's frame caught up to its substance. Multiple artefacts produced. From direct conversation, [SOLID].

## **o9. The Gap — opening section, first shape**

*Filename:* MTG-The-Gap-Opening-Section-FINAL-23May2026.docx (early version)

**[SOLID]** Initial 1,200-word opening section between Author's Note and Chapter 1. Built from Paul's 600-word substrate. Original eight paragraphs.

## **10. The Gap — full opening with The Gap Will Flex section**

*Filename:* MTG-The-Gap-Full-Opening-23May2026.docx

**[SOLID]** Extended opening adding the Monet thread, coding precedent, voice trajectory through 2027–2028, and the book’s-one-job paragraph.

## **11. The Closing Move — proposed footnote**

*Filename:* MTG-The-Closing-Move-23May2026.docx

**[SOLID]** The throwaway-register footnote handling the categorical claim and the Neuralink-shaped possibility. Two paragraphs. Approximately 120 words for the move.

## **12. The Gap — opening section FINAL**

*Filename:* MTG-The-Gap-Opening-Section-FINAL-23May2026.docx

**[SOLID]** Final 1,215-word opening section. Original eight paragraphs + The gap will flex sub-section + closing footnote + Paul’s verbatim landing line. Ready for placement.

## **13. It’s My Turn — journal artefact v3 FINAL**

*Filename:* Its\_My\_Turn\_Journal\_Artefact\_23May2026\_v3.docx

**[RECONSTRUCTED]** Final version of the watershed journal piece. 2,916 words. [name held] full lyric. Paul’s NGE recognition. Bowlby quote in full. Jean Bond dedication section. From transcript summary.

## **14. Chapter 6 + 6A paste-in document**

*Filename:* MTG-Chapter-6-and-6A-Paste-In-23May2026.docx

**[SOLID]** 4,339 words. Complete integration. Chapter 6 intact with memory observation inserted near close. Chapter 6A “What Lies Beneath” with NGE moment opening, bridge, Defending the Gap verbatim, citation block. Single paste-in document.

## **15. Chapter 6 + 6A structural plan**

*Filename:* MTG-C6-and-C6A-Structural-Plan-23May2026.docx

**[SOLID]** 1,776 words. The structural plan produced before drafting, mapping the integration scene by scene. What stays, what changes, what enters from each source document. Approved by Paul before the paste-in was built.

## **16. C6/6A Learning Paper**

*Filename:* MTG-C6-6A-Learning-Paper.docx

**[SOLID]** 1,930 words. Journal artefact reflecting on what the integration work revealed about Paul, the book, and the AI. Three-section structure plus collective observation. Held in project archive, not in manuscript.

## **17. Epigraph working map**

*Filename:* MTG-Epigraph-Working-Map.docx

**[SOLID]** 2,422 words. Chapter-by-chapter epigraph candidate analysis. Eight strong fits proposed (Chapters 1, 4, 5, 6, 6A, 9, 10, 12); five chapters held without epigraph. Paul's two own lines used: 15 November 2006 line for Chapter 1; "all behaviour is learned" for Chapter 6A.

## **PHASE THREE — 24 May 2026 (Book Two scoping)**

### **18. Book Two Scoping Note**

*Filename:* MTG-Book-Two-Scoping-Note.docx

**[SOLID]** 2,864 words. Scoping note for the future book "All Behaviour Is Learned. Not All Behaviour Is Taught." Honest read of whether the book exists (yes), who it is for, why it would be bought, the developmental spine, the publication sequencing, what cannot be seen from the outside. Archived. Not opened until Mind the Gap launches.

### **19. Book Two Concept Paper**

**[SOLID]** 2,135 words. The expanded concept paper for external AI review. Twelve sections including the framework as substrate (NGE-FOF surfacing in jobs, Hunter-

Farmer, Pegs/Holes/Hammers), why now, why this author, risks named honestly, the single-sentence claim. Built to invite triangulation.

## **20. Cowork scanning prompt v1**

**[SOLID]** 1,751 words. First version of the prompt for Claude in Cowork to scan Paul's My Documents folder and surface material for the future book. Seven content categories, eight-field inventory entries, separate summary section with framework footprint.

## **21. Cowork scanning prompt v2**

*Filename:* MTG-Cowork-Scanning-Prompt-v2.docx

**[SOLID]** 2,128 words. Revised version after Paul surfaced that NGE-FOF is the canonical substrate of the new book, not adjacent. Twelve content categories. Framework footprint named explicitly. Substantively stronger than v1.

## **22. Status Anchor**

*Filename:* MTG-Status-Anchor.docx

**[SOLID]** 1,137 words. Strategic anchor document for any new editorial thread. Six sections: where the book is; decisions outstanding; what does not matter this week; the single next physical action; what Claude should do; what this document is not. Built to stop the drift toward comma-level work in compacted threads.

## **PHASE FOUR — 27 May 2026 (thread retirement)**

## **23. Book Man — Legacy Reflection**

*Filename:* MTG-Book-Man-Legacy-Reflection.docx

**[SOLID]** 4,270 words. Long-form reflection across five movements: who I was, where we began, what I carried, what has drifted, what I want returned. Honest about **[SOLID]**, **[RECONSTRUCTED]**, **[DRIFTED]** memory. For Paul, and for whoever takes up the name when the book is finished.

## **24. Full Artefact List — this document**

*Filename:* MTG-Book-Man-Artefact-List.docx

**[SOLID]** This document. Chronological inventory of all artefacts produced or referenced in the Book Man thread. Confidence-marked. For Paul's archive.

### **Summary by phase**

Phase One (18–22 May): 8 artefacts — mostly [RECONSTRUCTED] from transcript summary. Defending the Gap essay; journal; methodology paper; listening pass catalogue; Artefact Library versions; Reflective Interlude reference.

Phase Two (23 May — the watershed): 9 artefacts — mostly [SOLID] from live thread. Opening section in multiple forms; closing move; It's My Turn v3; Chapter 6+6A integration with structural plan; learning paper; epigraph map.

Phase Three (24 May — Book Two scoping): 5 artefacts — [SOLID]. Scoping note; concept paper; two versions of Cowork prompt; Status Anchor.

Total artefacts in this thread: 24. Of which 16 are [SOLID] (direct production in live conversation) and 8 are [RECONSTRUCTED] from transcript summary or pre-thread references.

### **Cross-references not produced here but central to the project**

The following are referenced extensively in this thread but were produced in earlier threads or by other contributors. Listed for completeness.

Manuscript versions through V42. Produced by Paul, shaped through this thread and others, executed against by Jose. Current state: 45,556 words, 15 chapters.

### **Honest closing note**

This list may be incomplete. The transcript summary at the top of this thread covers the earlier weeks; small artefacts produced in those weeks may not appear here if the summary did not preserve them. Paul will have local copies in his outputs folder and can cross-check.

Where filenames are given, they reflect what I can see in the /mnt/user-data/outputs/ directory at thread retirement, or what the transcript summary names. Paul's local archive will be authoritative.
