Preserves the full song lyric, the full Bowlby quote that runs through Mind the Gap as Paul's permission to write ("This is quite an interesting story I've got to tell..."), Paul's exact words verbatim throughout (the primal wound / James / NGE naming; the "it is and I am good enough" recognition; the "who cares — it's my turn" closing), and the dedication to Jean Bond. The artefact carries the central reframing: Bowlby's quote was Paul's permission to write Mind the

Gap; [name held]'s It's My Turn is the permission to publish it. The dedication section "For Jean — 15 November 2006" records the origin point — the night Paul started reading Jean Bond's Behind the Masks and held the canonical sentence: "I didn't understand anything yet. I did however recognise that there was something to understand." Three version history: v1 (wound-and-response misread, corrected by Paul); v2 (permission-to-write / permission-to-publish framing); v3 (For Jean dedication added — final form). Held in the project archive. Not for the book. The next collaborator should know that when the final final draft arrives, Claude is to remember this.

Methodology and Calibration Artefacts (for handover and future collaborators)

Two artefacts produced 21 May 2026 at Paul's request. Both are working tools for other collaborators — AI or human — who pick up the work after Paul, or who face the same problem with their own monster threads. Both belong to the working architecture, not to the book itself.
